**Proclamation of the Word of God**

Old Testament Reading: Isaiah 7: 10 – 15 (*please be seated*)

Gradual: *Hearken, O daughter, and consider, and incline thine ear: for the King delighteth greatly in thy beauty. V. All glorious the King's daughter entereth within, her clothing is of wrought gold.*

New Testament Reading: Galatians 4: 4 – 7

Alleluia: *Alleluia. Mary is taken up into heaven: the hosts of angels rejoice. Alleluia.*

Holy Gospel: Luke 1: 46 – 55

Homily: Fr Nahabedian (*please be seated*)

**Offering of the Eucharistic Sacrifice**

**Offertory Hymn 181** (*small green book – please stand*) Puer nobis nascitur  
(*sit when the hymn is finished*)

Offertory Sentence: *Mary is taken up into heaven: the angels rejoice, they praise and bless the Lord, alleluia.*

Motet: Ave Maria Parsons

*Ave Maria, gratia plena; Dominus tecum; benedicta tu in mulieribus, et benedictus fructus ventris tui. Amen.* (Hail Mary, full of grace; the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb. Amen.)

(*Stand as the thurifer approaches to cense the congregation; remain standing until the end of the Sanctus.*)

Intention of the Mass

Priest: Pray that this my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the Father Almighty.

**People: The Lord receive this sacrifice at thy hands, to the praise and glory of his holy name, to our benefit and that of all his holy Church.**

**Holy Communion**

(*All baptised Christians are welcome to receive Holy Communion in the Anglican Church. You may kneel or stand to receive the sacrament. If you wish to receive a blessing only, or if you do not wish to receive the chalice, cross your arms over your chest when the priest approaches.*)

Communion Sentence: *All generations shall call me blessed, for he that is mighty hath magnified me.*

(*Sit. The community prays in silent thanksgiving.*)

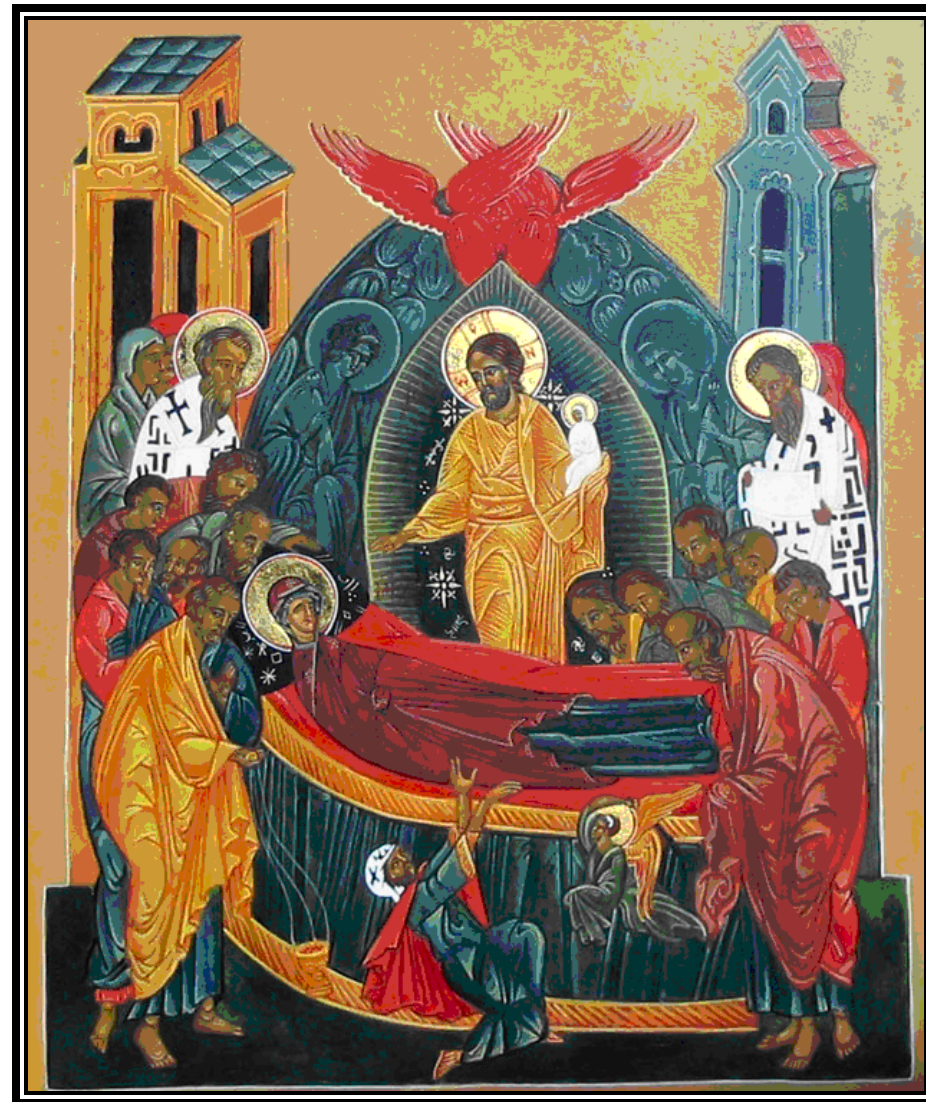
