Offertory Sentence: *An Angel stood by the altar of the temple, having a golden censer in his hand: and there was given unto him much incense: and the smoke of the incense ascended up before God, Alleluia*

There was silence in heaven while the dragon joined battle with the Archangel Michael. A cry was heard - thousands of thousands saying: "Salvation and honour and power be to Almighty God". Alleluia.

All who are **baptised** with water in the name of the Holy Trinity are welcome to receive **Holy Communion** in the Anglican Church. **At the time of Communion** you may receive bread and wine **OR** bread only. However, **intinction** (dipping bread into the wine) is **no** longer allowed. You may kneel or stand to receive communion.

Washrooms are in the basement which can be reached from the door beside the font. There is a **wheelchair-accessible lift and washroom** in the office area.
