First Reading: Isaiah 2: 1-5 (*please sit*) Lector: *Leslie Anne Chatterton*

Gradual: *For all they that look for thee shall not be ashamed, O Lord. V. Make known unto me thy ways, O Lord: and teach me thy paths.*

Second Reading: Romans 13: 11-14

Alleluia: *Alleluia. Show us thy mercy, O Lord: and grant us thy salvation. Alleluia.*

Offertory Sentence: *Unto thee, O Lord, lift I up my soul: O my God, in thee have I trusted, let me not be confounded: neither let mine enemies triumph over me: for all they that look for thee shall not be ashamed.*

Motet: *Rorate Coeli* JOSEF RHEINBERGER

Rorate caeli desuper, et nubes pluant iustum: aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem. Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness.
