Gradual: *Keep thou me, O Lord, as the apple of an eye: hide thou me under the shadow of thy wings. V. Let my sentence come forth from thy presence: and let thine eyes look upon the thing that is equal.*

Second Reading: Colossians 1: 1 - 14

Alleluia: *Alleluia. Thou, O God, art praised in Syon: and unto thee shall the vow be performed in Jerusalem. Alleluia.*

**Offering of the Eucharistic Sacrifice**

Offertory Hymn ..... Blue Book No. 13  
(Please sit when the hymn is finished)

Offertory Sentence: *Unto thee, O Lord, lift I up my soul: O my God, in thee have I trusted, let me not be confounded: neither let mine enemies triumph over me: for all they that look for thee shall not be ashamed.*

Motet: Ave Verum Corpus MARTIN

*Ave, verum corpus natum de Maria Virgine: vere passum immolatum in cruce pro homine: cujus; unda fluxit sanguine; O Jesu, Fili Mariae, Miserere nobis. Amen. (Hail the true body, born of the Virgin Mary: You who truly suffered and were sacrificed on the cross for the sake of man. From whose pierced flank flowed water and blood: Be a foretaste for us in the trial of death.) (O tender, O loving, O Jesu Son of Mary; have mercy on me.)*

*(Stand as the thurifer approaches to cense the congregation; remain standing until the end of the Sanctus.)*

Intention of the Mass

Priest: Pray that this my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the Father Almighty.

People: **The Lord receive this sacrifice at thy hands, to the praise and glory of his holy name, to our benefit and that of all his holy Church.**
