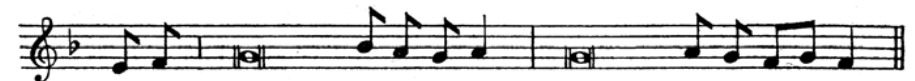

- C: THE LORD, the God of gods, has spo-ken : he has called the earth from the rising of the sun to its sët-ting.
- P: **Out of Zion, perfect in its beau-ty : God reveals him-self in glö-ry.**
- C: Our God will come and will not keep si-lence : before him there is a consuming flame, and round about him a rag-ing storm.
- P: **He calls the heavens and the earth from a-bove : to witness the judgement of his pëo-ple.**
- C: "Gather before me my loy-al fol-low-ers : those who have made a covenant with me and sealed it with sa-cri-fice."
