Collect of the Day

First Reading: Jeremiah 2: 4-13 (please sit) Lector: William Bliussett

Gradual: The nations shall fear thy name, O Lord, and all the kings of the earth thy majesty. V. When the Lord shall build up Sion, he shall appear in his glory.

Second Reading: Hebrews 13: 1-8, 15-16

Alleluia: Alleluia. O sing unto the Lord a new song: because he hath done marvellous things. Alleluia.

Offertory Hymn 391 (small green book) GWALCHMAI (Please sit when the hymn is finished)

Offertory Sentence: Look down, O Lord, haste thee to help me: let them be ashamed and confounded that seek after my soul to destroy it: look down, O Lord, haste thee to help me.

Motet: Ave Verum Corpus BYRD

Ave, verum corpus natum de Maria Virgine: vere passum immolatum in cruce pro homine: cuius latus perforatum unda fluxit et sanguine, esto nobis praegustatum in mortis examine. O dulcis, O pie, O Jesu Fili Mariae; miserere mei. (Hail the true body, born of the Virgin Mary: You who truly suffered and were sacrificed on the cross for the sake of man. From whose pierced flank flowed water and blood: Be a foretaste for us in the trial of death.) (O tender, O loving, O Jesu Son of Mary; have mercy on me.)

(Stand as the thurifer approaches to cense the congregation; remain standing until the end of the Sanctus.)

Intention of the Mass

Priest: Pray that this my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the Father Almighty.

People: The Lord receive this sacrifice at thy hands, to the praise and glory of his holy name, to our benefit and that of all his holy Church.

Prayer over the Gifts

Celebrant: The Lord be with you. People: And with thy spirit.

Celebrant: Lift up your hearts. People: We lift them up unto the Lord.

Celebrant: Let us give thanks unto our Lord God. People: It is meet and right so to do.
