Offertory Hymn 493 (small green book) WAREHAM (please sit when the hymn is finished)

Offertory Sentence: Then consecrated Moses an altar unto the Lord, offering burnt offerings upon it, and sacrificing peace offerings: and he made an evening sacrifice for a sweet-smelling savour unto the Lord God, in the sight of the children of Israel.

Motet: Adoramus te Christe LASSUS

Adoramus te, Christe, et benedicimus tibi, quia per tuam sanctam crucem redemisti mundum. (We adore thee, O Christ, and we bless thee, because by thy holy cross thou hast redeemed the world.)
