**Greeting** (*stand*)

*Celebrant:* The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

**People:** **And with thy spirit.**

Collect of the Day

First Reading: Jeremiah 29: 1, 4-7 (please sit) Lector: Lillian Scott

Gradual: Behold, how good and joyful a thing it is, brethren, to dwell together in unity. V. It is like the precious ointment upon the head: that ran down unto the beard, even the beard of Aaron.

Second Reading: II Timothy 2: 8-15

Alleluia: Alleluia. Ye that fear the Lord, put your trust in the Lord: he is their helper and defender. Alleluia.

Holy Gospel: Luke 17: 5-10

Sermon: Fr Harrison (please sit)

Nicene Creed (please stand and bow at the Incarnatus)... Blue Book No. 112

Prayers of the People (as announced) Response: Lord, have mercy. Final Response: To thee, O Lord.

Confession and Absolution (please kneel) ..... Blue Book p. 142

Kiss of Peace Celebrant: The peace of the Lord be always with you. People: And with thy spirit.

Offering of the Eucharistic Sacrifice

Offertory Hymn 261 GOLDEN SHEAVES (please sit when the hymn is finished)

Offertory Sentence: Remember me, O Lord, thou mighty King of all power: and put eloquent speech into my mouth, that my words may be pleasing in the sight of the prince.

Motet: Sacerdotes Domini WILLIAM BYRD The priests of the Lord offered incense and bread to their God, and did not defile his Name. Alleluia.

(Stand as the thurifer approaches to cense the congregation; remain standing until the end of the Sanctus.)

Intention of the Mass Priest: Pray that this my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the Father Almighty. People: The Lord receive this sacrifice at thy hands, to the praise and glory of his holy name, to our benefit and that of all his holy Church.

Prayer over the Gifts Sursum Corda ..... Blue Book No. 116 Celebrant: The Lord be with you. People: And with thy spirit. Celebrant: Lift up your hearts. People: We lift them up unto the Lord. Celebrant: Let us give thanks unto our Lord God. People: It is meet and right so to do.

Sanctus ..... Text - Blue Book p. 143 Eucharistic Prayer B (please kneel) ..... Blue Book p. 145 Lord's Prayer ..... Blue Book No. 117 The Fraction ..... Blue Book p. 146 Agnus Dei ..... Text - Blue Book p. 146

Holy Communion (you may kneel or stand) Communion Sentence: Aufer a me opprobrium et contemptum, quia mandata tua exquisivi, Domine: nam et testimonia tua meditatio me a est. (Remove from me reproach and contempt, for I have kept thy laws: thy testimonies also are my delight.)

Choir: Psalm 8 (Sit. The community prays in silent thanksgiving.)
