Gradual: *One thing have I desired of the Lord, which I will require: even that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life. - Blessed are they that dwell in thy house, O Lord: they will be alway praising thee.*

Second Reading: II Timothy 4: 6-8, 16-18

### **Offering of the Eucharistic Sacrifice**

Offertory Sentence: *Domine, vivifica me secundum loquium tuum: ut sciam testimonia tua.* (O Lord, grant me life according to your word, so that I may learn your commandments.)

Motet: *Avre Verum Corpus* HEALEY WILLAN

*Hail, true Body, born of the Virgin Mary, truly, thou suffered on the cross for mankind: From whose pierced side water flowed with blood. O be thou our food in our hour of death. O gentle, O loving, O Jesu, O Son of Mary, have mercy on me. Amen.*

*(Stand as the thurifer approaches to cense the congregation; remain standing until the end of the Sanctus.)*

**People: We lift them up unto the Lord.**

*Celebrant: Let us give thanks unto our Lord God.*
