(Stand as the thurifer approaches to cense the congregation; remain standing until the end of the Sanctus.)

Gradual: We have waited, O God, for thy loving-kindness in the midst of thy temple: according to thy name, O Lord, so is thy praise unto the world's end. V. Like as we have heard, so also have we seen, in the city of our God, even upon his holy hill.

Second Reading: II Thessalonians 1: 1-4, 11-12
