- **Saying farewell to Maylanne:** Our deacon, **Canon Maylanne Maybee**, has been appointed **Principal of the Centre for Christian Studies in Winnipeg**, a post she takes up on August 1st. **Her last Sunday at SMM will be our Patronal Festival, Sunday, July 24th.** As a way of giving thanks for Maylanne's ministry and presence at SMM over many years, **we are inviting contributions to a fund designated to restore a treasured set of high mass vestments.** These white vestments (characterized by red orphreys and exquisite embroidery) were donated to the parish by Bill and June Greig.
