- **June Liturgies**
 - **Pentecost: NEXT Sunday:** Said Mass at 8.00am, Sung Mass at 9.30 am, Procession and Solemn Mass at 11.00 am.
 - **Trinity Sunday (June 19th):** Said Mass at 8.00 am, Folk Mass at 9.30 am, Procession and Solemn Mass at 11.00 am, and Solemn Evensong and Benediction at 4.30 pm.
 - **Solemnity of Corpus Christi (June 26th):** Said Mass at 8.00 am, Sung Mass at 9.30 am, Solemn Mass and Outdoor Procession at 11.00 am.
 - **The Feast of SS. Peter and Paul (Wednesday, June 29th):** Said Mass at 10.00 am, Procession and Solemn Mass at 6.00 pm, followed by a pot luck supper.
- On two more Friday nights this June, SMM will present a series called "*Concerts Spirituels*", concerts that open our church to our neighbours and friends and allow them to enjoy sacred music in this beautiful space. Each programme involves **choral**

music, baroque chamber music and organ music. On **June 10**, ensemble **Theotokos** will perform **Guerrero's *Missa Simile est Regnum***, and on **June 17**, **Pax Christi Chamber Choir** will sing **Palestrina's *Missa Aeterna Christi Munera***. All concerts are at **8pm**, and are **"come as you are; pay what you can."**

- **Chattanooga Boys Choir: Next Sunday, 12 June, Pentecost Sunday**, the Chattanooga Boys Choir from Tennessee, USA will be our **guest choir at the 11 am Mass**. Founded in 1954, this is the oldest boy choir in the southeast United States. They have performed in over 20 countries on 5 continents and recently have recorded for the NAXOS label. **Please help us welcome these young singers to SMM.**
