Second Reading: Acts 10: 34-43

Alleluia: *Alleluia. I have found David my servant; with my holy oil have I anointed him. Alleluia.*

Celebrant: The peace of the Lord be always with you.

Offering of the Eucharistic Sacrifice

Offertory Hymn: 12 (*small green book*) WINCHESTER NEW
(Please sit when the hymn is finished.)

Offertory Sentence: *Benedictus qui venit nomine Domini: benediximus vobis de domo Domini: Deus Dominus, et illuxit nobis, alleluia, alleluia.* (Blessed is he that comes in the name of the Lord: we bless you from the house of the Lord: the Lord is God, and he has given us light.)

Motet: *Sicut Servus GIOVANNI PIERLUIGI DA PALESTRINA*
Sicut cervus desiderat ad fontes aquarum, ita desiderat anima mea ad te, Deus. Sitivit anima mea ad Deum fortem vivum: quando veniam et apparebo ante faciem Dei? Fuerunt mihi lacrymae meae panes die ac nocte, dum dicitur mihi quotidie: Ubi est Deus tuus? Like as the hart desireth the waterbrooks, so longeth my soul unto Thee, O God. My soul is a thirst for God, yea even for the living God. When shall I come to appear before the presence of God? My tears have been my meat day and night; while they daily say unto me, Where is now thy God?

(Stand as the thurifer approaches to cense the congregation; remain standing until the end of the Sanctus.)

Intention of the Mass

Celebrant: Pray that this my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the Father Almighty.

People: The Lord receive this sacrifice at thy hands, to the praise and glory of his holy name, to our benefit and that of all his holy Church.

Prayer over the Gifts

Celebrant: The Lord be with you.

People: And with thy spirit.

Celebrant: Lift up your hearts.

People: We lift them up unto the Lord.

Celebrant: Let us give thanks unto our Lord God.
