## **The Celebration of the Eucharist**

MON DIEU

*During the hymn the bread and wine are presented and an offering is taken to support the life and work of this parish and the wider Church. Please sit when the hymn is finished and remain seated until after the Offertory Sentence)*

**Offertory Sentence:** *Mary, full of grace: the Lord is with thee: blessèd art thou among women, alleluia.*

**Motet:** *Alma Redemptoris Mater, quae pervia caeli porta manes, et stella maris, succurre cadenti, surgere qui curat populo: Tu quae genuisti, natura mirante, tuum sanctum Genitorem: Virgo prius ac posterius, Gabrielis ab ore sumens illud Ave, peccatorum miserere.* Loving Mother of the Redeemer, who remains the gate by which we mortals enter heaven, and star of the sea, help your fallen people who strive to rise: You who gave birth, amazing nature, to your sacred Creator: Virgin prior and following, taking from the mouth of Gabriel that: Hail! Have mercy on us sinners.

Celebrant: Pray, my brothers and sisters, that this my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the Father Almighty.

People **The Lord receive this sacrifice at thy hands, to the praise and glory of his holy name, to our benefit and that of all his holy Church.**

*The celebrant prays the Prayer over the Gifts.*

**The Great Thanksgiving** (*Music: Blue SMM Book No. 116*)

Celebrant: The Lord be with you. People: **And with thy spirit.**  
Celebrant: Lift up your hearts. People: **We lift them up unto the Lord.**  
Celebrant: Let us give thanks unto our Lord God.  
People: **It is meet and right so do to.**

*The celebrant continues to pray Eucharistic Prayer B. You may follow the text on page 145 in the "Liturgies" section of the Blue SMM Book.*

### **Sanctus**

Gregorian Mass

*Holy, holy, holy, Lord God of Hosts, heaven and earth are full of thy glory. Glory be to thee, O Lord most high. Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord: Hosanna in the highest.*

*Please kneel. The Eucharistic Prayer continues.*

**We praise thee, we bless thee, we thank thee, and we pray to thee, Lord our God.**

*At the end of the prayer all respond: Amen.*

**The Lord's Prayer** (*Music: Blue SMM Book No. 117*)

Celebrant: As now as our Saviour Christ hath taught us, we are bold to say:  
All: **Our Father, who art in heaven:  
Hallowed be thy name:  
Thy Kingdom come:  
Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread.  
And forgive us our trespasses,  
as we forgive those who trespass against us.  
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.**

**For thine is the Kingdom,  
the power and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.**

Celebrant: Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us;  
People: **Therefore, let us keep the feast.**
