Proclamation of the Word of God

First Reading: Leviticus 19: 1-2, 9-18 (*Please sit.*) Lector: *Leslie Anne Chatterton*

Gradual: *Ego Dixi: Domine, Miserere mei: sana animam meam, quoniam peccavimus qui inteligit super egenum et pauperem: in die mala liberabit eum Dominus.* (I said, Lord me merciful unto me: heal my soul, for I have sinned against thee. V. Blessed is he that considereth the poor and needy: the Lord shall deliver him in the time of trouble.)

Second Reading: I Corinthians 3: 10-11, 16-23

Alleluia: *Alleluia. Verba mea auribus percipe, Domine: intellige clamorem meum. Alleluia.* (Ponder my words, O Lord: consider my meditation. Alleluia.)

Offertory Sentence: *Intende voci orationis meae, Res meus, et Deus meus: quoniam ad te orabo, Domine.* (O hearken thou unto the voice of my calling, my King and my God: for unto thee will I make my prayer.)

Motet: Jubilate Deo ORLANDO DI LASSO
Jubilate Deo, omnis terra; servite Domino in lætitia. Intrate in conspectu eius in exultatione, quia Dominus ipse est Deus. (Sing joyfully to God, all the earth, serve ye the Lord with gladness; come in before His presence with exceeding great joy; for the Lord He is God.)

(*Stand as the thurifer approaches to cense the congregation; remain standing until the end of the Sanctus.*)

People: The Lord receive this sacrifice at thy hands, to the praise and glory of his holy name, to our benefit and that of all his holy Church.
