P: He lifted me out of the desolate pit, out of the mire and clay: he set my feet upon a high cliff and made my foot-ing sure.

C: He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God: many shall see and stand in awe and put their trust in the Lord.

P: Happy are they who trust in the Lord: they do not resort to evil spirits or turn to false gods.

C: Great things are they that you have done, O Lord my God! how great are your wonders and your plans for us : there is none who can be com-pared with you.

P: Oh that I could make them known and tell them: but they are more than I can count.

C: In sacrifice and offering you take no plea-sure: you have given me ears to hear you.

P: **Burnt-offering and sin-offering you have not re-quir'd:** and so I said, "**Be**-hold I come.

C: "In the roll of the book it is written concerning me: 'I love to do your will, O my God; your law is deep in my heart.'"

P: **I proclaimed righteousness in the great congre-ga-tion: behold I did not restrain my lips, and that, O Lord, you know.**

C: Your righteousness have I not hidden in my heart; I have spoke of your faithfulness and your de-li-v'rance :

P. **I have not concealed your love and faithfulness from the great con-gre-ga-tion.**
