Eia, ergo, advocata nostra, illos tuos misericordes oculos ad nos converte; et Iesum, benedictum fructum ventris tui, nobis post hoc exsiliium ostende. O clemens, O pia, O dulcis Virgo Maria. People: The Lord receive this sacrifice at thy hands, to the praise and glory of his holy name, to our benefit and that of all his holy Church.

Holy Communion

(*All baptised Christians are welcome to receive Holy Communion in the Anglican Church. You may kneel or stand to receive the sacrament. If you*

wish to receive a blessing only, or if you do not wish to receive the chalice, cross your arms over your chest when the priest approaches.)

Communion Sentence: *All generations shall call me blessed, for he that is mighty hath magnified me.* (Choir: Magnificat)
(Sit. The community prays in silent thanksgiving.)

Solemn Blessing (*After each of the four paragraphs of the Solemn Blessing, the people answer: Amen.*)

Dismissal (*you may stand*) **Blue Book p. 118**

WELCOME TO OUR VISITORS

Visitors are invited to sign one of the guest books in the narthex. **Full music hymn books**, or **large print hymn books** are available from sidespersons. All who are **baptised** with water in the name of the Holy Trinity are welcome to receive **Holy Communion** in the Anglican Church. **At the time of Communion** you may receive bread and wine **OR** bread only. However, **intinction** (dipping bread into the wine) is **no** longer allowed. You may kneel or stand to receive communion.

Washrooms are in the basement which can be reached from the door beside the font. There is a **wheelchair-accessible lift and washroom** in the office area. Please speak to one of the sidespersons.
