Exaudi orationem meam: ad te omnis caro veniet.* (Rest eternal grant unto them, O Lord: and may light perpetual shine upon them. Thou, O God, art praised in Sion, and unto thee shall the vow be performed in Jerusalem; thou that hearest the prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come.)

Lector: Lillian Scott

Gradual: *Rest eternal grant to them, O Lord: and may light perpetual shine upon them. V. The righteous shall be had in everlasting remembrance: he will not be afraid of any evil tidings.*

New Testament Reading: I Peter 1: 3 – 9

Tract: *Absolve, O Lord, the souls of all the faithful departed from every bond of sin. And by the help of thy grace may they be worthy to escape the avenging judgement. And enjoy the blessedness of everlasting light.*

Responsory: *Deliver me, O Lord, from death eternal in that fearful day: when the heavens and the earth shall be shaken: when thou shalt come to do judgement on the world by fire. I am in fear and trembling till the sifting be upon us and the wrath to come. When the heavens and the earth shall be shaken. Ah that day, that*

day of anger, of calamity, and of misery; a great day and exceeding bitter when thou shalt come to judgement on the world by fire. Rest eternal grant unto them, O Lord: and let light perpetual shine upon them.

Give rest, O Christ, to thy servants with thy Saints; where sorrow and pain are no more; neither sighing but life everlasting. Thou only art immortal, the creator and Maker of man: and we are mortal, formed of the earth, and unto earth shall we return: for so thou didst ordain, when thou createdst me, saying, Dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return. All we go down to the dust; and, weeping o'er the grave, we make our song: alleluia, alleluia, alleluia. Give rest, O Christ...

WELCOME TO OUR VISITORS

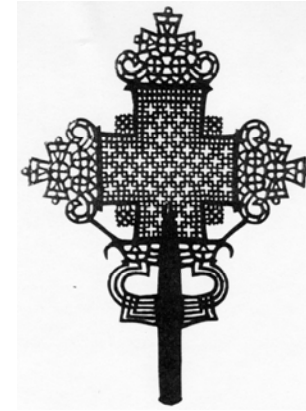
Visitors are invited to sign one of the guest books in the narthex. **Full music hymn books**, or **large print hymn books** are available from sidespersons.
